Mayor McCoy Breaks Ground on Historic Talcottville Improvements

Vernon, CT – Mayor Jason L. McCoy was joined yesterday by various representatives from the community to break ground on the construction phase of the Historic Talcottville Improvements Project.

The planned improvements will include the creation of a Talcottville Village walking tour covering historically significant properties and sites along the Main Street and Elm Hill Road areas. The enhancements will also include a visitor's kiosk, informational signage, landscaping, fencing, streetlights, bike racks and sidewalk construction. During the ceremony, Mayor McCoy stated "this project will enhance this unique local historic village," and that Historic Talcottville is a "great area of the state and will attract people to Vernon."
