Sandra called the meeting to order at 7:05.

The treasurer's report was given by Lisa with \$2380.47 in the VAC account and \$2620.85 in the Friends account. Report approved.

With the mailings to renewal members and potential new members for the FVAC, the amount received as of today is close to what was received last year, with some not renewing and some new members.

After much discussion a motion was made by Sandra to give the Vernon Chorale a total of \$1000, broken down by \$750 performance and \$250 advertising. These funds are to be used at the concerts held in Vernon only and paperwork must be submitted by the Chorale with specifics as to how these funds are to be spent in the two categories. Passed.

No reports on the Volunteer Collaborative.

Sandra reported that Nicole Fillion, grant writer for Vernon Public Schools is working on a grant for the overpass project. The group working on the overpass project is also working with Arts in Schools program to get the Vernon schools involved.

Lisa reported that the cost for the VAC website without ads will be \$59.37. She also stated that she has some of the contact info for the schools to use the VAC funds and will email them out as well as send info to the schools.

Ginny stated that she will be away Jan.-April. Sandra will be away Dec. and Feb. There is concern re: having enough commissioners to vote on items during those months and also recruiting more commissioners. John Kopec stated that aside from Planning and Zoning, the town also is having trouble filling it's commissioner seats.

Donna talked of eventually discussing giving one or more scholarships this year from the FVAC account. Scholarships are given anywhere from \$100 to \$2000. She also suggested listing the winners in the newspapers giving the students the recognition they deserve and the VAC some publicity. She also stated that it would give the VAC recognition if a commissioner would attend the Awards night to present the scholarship(s). Lisa stated that the advertising needs to be done by the chairperson of the scholarship committee. No decision made.

Meeting dates for 2015 need to be in by January and should be set at the next meeting. Looking at the calendar, the only meeting that would be other than the first Monday of the month is Labor Day next year.

It was decided that Irma would chair the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:58.
