Pledge of allegiance

Mayor Daniel A. Champagne called the public hearing/annual town meeting to order at 7:00PM.

There were approximately 65 persons present at the Annual Town Meeting including the Mayor and Members of the Town Council.

Interim Town Clerk, Karen Daigle read into the record the legal notice of the Public Hearing/Annual Town Meeting and certified the notice was posted on the bulletin board in the Town Hall and published in the Journal Inquirer in the April 14, 2018 edition.

Mayor called for nominations for a moderator. Steve Wakefield, seconded by Laura Bush made a motion for Jim Luddecke as the moderator. Motion carried.

As Moderator Mr. Luddecke explained the requirements necessary to vote at the Referendum as to residence, age and ownership of property.

The Moderator then asked if anyone present wanted to comment on the budget:

Ralph Zahner, 142 Vernon Avenue, Apt. 66, spoke regarding the potential for a lower budget and residents to review the budget.

Mayor Daniel A. Champagned clarified aspects of the budget including the Sewer Plant, Rockville Public Library and Center 375 Roof Project.

Ralph Zahner, 142 Vernon Avenue, Apt 66 reiterated his original statement after comments from the Mayor.
