1. Call to Order & Roll Call

C. Application related correspondence: IWC and PZC applications

Application (IWC-2014-09) of Richard Topp for a Wetlands Redesignation and Wetlands permit for 658 Bolton Road (Assessor's ID: Map #54, Block #139, Lot/Parcel #74).

- Commissioner Ouellette submitted a Natural Diversity Data Base map from the DEEP, in which Applicant's property is right in the middle of.
