

Regular Meeting Minutes - DRAFT
Town of Vernon Economic Development Commission

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1. Call to Order – Meeting called to order by Chairperson Jeffrey Cohen at 7:41 AM. Those present were Peter Olson, Meghan Scranton, Bill Breslau, Bill McGurk, and Shaun Gately. Jill Merriam arrived at 7:55 AM. Those absent were Vincent Shaheen, Bruce Kellogg, Dan Kennedy and Jim Sendrak.
2. Public Forum – No one present at public forum.
3. Approval of Minutes from meeting on March 13, 2013 – *A motion to approve the March 13, 2013 minutes was made by Peter Olson and seconded by Bill McGurk. Motion passed unanimously.*

5. Economic Development Status Update
 - A. Current Projects
 - Amerbelle
 - Mr. Gately is still working with the firm on their renovation plans for the plant but there is nothing to update commission on.
 - 200 West Main Street - The State of Connecticut is getting closer on a verdict with funding for this project.
 - Loom City Lofts and Talcott Brothers Mill –Loom City is waiting for closing date and Talcott Brothers Mill project is still discussing financing.
 - Kelly Road Hotel
 - The Town of Vernon has approved to re-map the site and bring the new wetlands mapping to the Wetlands Commission for approval.
 - OPM

 - Branding
 - The branding for the Town of Vernon is “On the Move.” This can be utilized in all departments of the town.
6. New Business

Approximately forty (40) people attended the Recognition Program that was held on March 28, 2013 at Key Hyundai. Mr. Cohen reported that there were many new faces in the crowd. It was well received and both Mr. Cohen and Ms. Merriam were thanked publicly for their contributions to the success of this event.

After a brief discussion, there was a consensus that a “Save the Date” should go out for this event and that the owners of the mill renovations should be invited. This event is being sponsored by two commission members Bill Breslau and Meghan Scranton.

- Job Fair
There was an informational meeting held on April 9th with approximately six (6) attendees. It was stated that MCC had just held their Job Fair and that perhaps the Vernon Job Fair might be too close from MCC's Job Fair and the Fall might be a better time to hold a Job Fair. After a discussion, it was determined that an educational workshop would be a good kickoff prior to the Job Fair. The educational workshop, which will be held on Saturday June 8, from 9AM to 1 PM at the Vernon Adult Education office, will include resume writing, "how to prepare and how to dress for an interview."

Mr. Gately continues his discussions with CCSU, ECSU and UConn business professors and is trying to get in touch with MCC for entrepreneurial discussions.
