**1. CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Steve Peterson.

**2. SHOW CAUSE HEARING**

2.1 Cease and Desist Order issued for 670 Dart Hill Road

Craig Perry was asked by town administration to visit the property due to neighborhood complaints.

Craig observed an excessive amount of wood chips being stock piled within an upland review area.

Owner, Ben Carlson, from Dart Hill Associates, Alpine Tree Removal and Timber Ridge Landscaping attended the meeting and provided the Commission with a map and a new plan. The new revised plan has not yet been submitted for approval.

PZC and IWC had both previously approved a plan several years ago.

Resident, Sue Perry, from 26 Emma Lane attended the meeting and expressed concern about possible spontaneous combustion of the wood chips. She was also advised by the DEP that berms should not be made out of wood chips.

Len Tundermann read a letter to the Commission from the DEP, Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division, dated March 19, 2010, to Ben Carlson, indicating a violation and required corrective actions.

Steve Peterson requested Craig to provide the Commission with a map of the actual wetland area for the next meeting in July.

Motion was made by Steve Peterson to retain the order and remove the wood chips off the regulated area to correct the order within the time period of the next IWC meeting in July and have Craig Perry monitor the area.

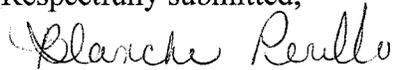
Motion was seconded by John Kopec. Motion carried 4-1 with Frank Galat opposing the vote.
