3. Public Hearing
 - 3.1 Application (**IWC-2014-04**) of Eric A. Santini and Kevin W. Santini for the
Redesignation of Wetlands and Wetlands permit to conduct a Significant
activity within a regulated area at the properties known as #1108, 1116
Hartford Turnpike and other adjoining parcel (Assessor's ID: Map #38,
Block #0068, Lot/Parcel #0020B, # 0021, #0021A).
