Declaration of Public Health and Civil Preparedness Emergency

WHEREAS, the Mayor does find:

In coordination with the State of Connecticut's response to the global pandemic of (COVID-19) disease associated with a novel coronavirus that is currently affecting multiple countries and states which has resulted in the spread of infections in Connecticut and surrounding states;

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that a public health and civil preparedness emergency exists throughout the Town of Vernon. It is further declared that during the existence of said emergency the Mayor shall exercise those powers, functions and duties prescribed by State law, the Town of Vernon Charter, and all applicable ordinances, resolutions, special acts, and the Town of Vernon's Emergency Operations Plan. Through a Unified Incident Command System, the Town will take such actions that are reasonably necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Vernon to minimize the effects of said emergency and to limit the transmission of the COVID-19 virus.
