Chairman explained that the purpose of the public hearing was to make changes to Section 8 – Fee Schedule of the Regulations of our Sanitary Code. The legal notice was printed in the Journal Inquirer and The Chronicle newspapers on August 30, 2017. The Chairman then turned the meeting over to Patrice Sulik to give a brief overview and reasoning for the changes.

Patrice explained there was one change that needed to be made to the Fee Schedule and that was the bottom of Page 1 – Reinspection Fee. We would like to make the effective date for this one item to be January 1, 2018, as there will be some major adjustments to make due to the cold holding temperature requirements in the new FDA Food Code that Connecticut is adopting.

No one spoke in favor or against the proposed revisions.
