Diane Wheelock, Chairman, stated the purpose of the public hearing was to review the District's proposed 2019-2020 budget. Attached are the Legal Notices which were printed in the Journal Inquirer and The Chronicle newspapers.

The balanced budget proposes no per capita increase over the present year. The per capita local share amount will remain at \$4.67. Each town's contribution will be based on the population which has increased at different rates in each of the towns; therefore, making individual town's increase vary accordingly. The District as a whole has seen an increase in population of 787.

No one was present from the public to speak in favor or against the proposed budget.

The public hearing on the proposed 2019-2020 budget was closed at 7:05 PM.
