Meeting Called to Order 6:05 p.m. by Chairman Adam Weissberger.

Those present: Town Council Members; Adam Weissberger, Tom DiDio and Dan Sullivan. Also in attendance: Town Administrator John D. Ward, Attorney Martin Burke, and Town Clerk Bernice K. Dixon. Town Council Member Ginny Gingras arrived at 6:10 p.m.

New Business: Discussion regarding Parking Ordinances took place as follows:

Ordinance # 98 – D. Sullivan, seconded by T. DiDio moved to remove Sec. IV and V from Ordinance # 98, as recommended by Atty. Burke. Motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance # 273 – T. DiDio, seconded by G. Gingras moved to change all fines in the Fine column for all offenses to \$50.00, with the exception of increasing the handicapped category to \$100, and raising all fines in the After 15 Days column to \$100.00 with an increase to \$150.00 for the handicapped category. Motion passed 3 – 1. A. Weissberger opposed.

Ordinance # 273 – T. DiDio, seconded by D. Sullivan moved to remove the redundant paragraph at the end of Section 2 in Ordinance # 273. Motion passed 3 – 1. A. Weissberger opposed.

Ordinance # 273 – T. DiDio, seconded by D. Sullivan moved to change the time in Section 6 from 3:30 A.M. to **3:00 A.M. to 5:00 A.M.** Motion passed 3-1. A. Weissberger opposed.

Ordinances # 182 & 238 – D. Sullivan, seconded by T. DiDio moved to adopt Chief Kenny's recommendation of changing the time from 3:30 A.M. to **3:00 A.M. to 5:00 A.M.**

as well as combining Ordinances # 182 and #238. Motion passed 3-1. A. Weissberger opposed.

Ordinance # 267 – T. DiDio, seconded by D. Sullivan moved to remove the underlines in Sections 5 and 6. Motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance # 266 – T. DiDio, seconded by G. Gingras moved to remove the underlines and brackets throughout the ordinance. Motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance # 244 – T. DiDio, seconded by G. Gingras moved to retain the ordinance in its current form. Motion passed unanimously.


