A motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of January 25, 2017 was made by Joe Correia, seconded by Joe Greco, and unanimously approved.


CITIZENS FORUM: None

INSPECTION OF TOWN BUILDINGS
VERNON CENTER MIDDLE SCHOOL
PERFORMED BY THE PERMANENT MUNICIPAL BUILDING COMMITTEE
FEBRUARY 22, 2017

1. The front entrance door mullions are rotting out at the base and should be repaired.
2. The boiler room fire door is rotting out and should be replaced.
3. The pneumatic compressor in the boiler room is missing the pressure switch cover.
4. There still appears to be roof leaks throughout the building.
5. Touch-up painting should be done throughout the building.
6. Additional clean-up efforts should be made in the custodial storage area; it was noted that some progress has been made.
7. The school is very well maintained and looks good.
