NOTICE TO APPLICANTS FOR RETAIL SALES PERMITS FOR PISTOLS AND REVOLVERS

1. Applicant must have either a valid eligibility certificate for a pistol or revolver, or a valid permit to carry a pistol or revolver. A copy will be made and returned to you. CGS Sec. 29-28(a) & CGS Sec. 29-36f(a)
2. The Town Building Official/Zoning Enforcement Officer must sign the application indicating that local zoning requirements have been met for the location where the sale of pistols or revolvers is to take place. Contact the Building Official, Building Department, 8 Park Place, telephone 870-3633. CGS Sec 29-28(a)
3. The fee for each permit issued or renewal of each permit for the sale of pistols or revolvers is \$200.00. The fee may be paid by bank check, money order or check, payable at the time you submit your application. Checks should be made payable to the "Town of Vernon". CGS Sec.29-30(a)
4. Complete the application for permit to sell pistols or revolvers. Please note that you must have your signature properly notarized before returning your application to the Vernon Police Department; this requires that you sign the application in the presence of the Notary, and the date of your signature must match that of the Notary's. The Notary must also indicate on the application form the date his or her commission expires. CGS Sec 29-28a(a)
5. Please include apartment number, suite number, floor number or building number on the address line if part of your address. Include PO Box number, in addition to your street address if you have one.
6. A separate application and permit are required for each location where pistols or revolvers are to be sold, offered or exposed for sale.
7. You will receive notification not later than eight (8) weeks after a sufficient application for a permit has been made. CGS Sec. 29-28a(b)
8. All local, state and federal laws and regulations must be complied with to keep the permit valid.
9. Applications are available from the Vernon Police Department Records Unit Monday through Friday, 7:00 am to 4:00 pm.
