Mayor McCoy: More Snow on the Way; DPW Pre-Treating; Urges Residents to Stay Home

Vernon, Conn., -- Mayor Jason L. McCoy today is urging residents to stay home if they do not need to go out during this evening's anticipated winter storm. Mayor McCoy is also reminding residents to use precaution and to be safe if they do go out.

"In anticipation of this evening's snow storm, Vernon DPW crews are clearing excess snow from the side of the streets and pre-treating the roads with salt," Mayor McCoy said. "I ask that residents, who do not need to go out this evening, stay in, to allow crews to efficiently and quickly clear the streets in preparation for the morning commute. In the event that residents do go out, it is important that they take precaution and drive safely."

"It is important that public safety is ensured and that unnecessary risks are avoided," Mayor McCoy said. "To that end, crews will be working all evening and all morning to ensure that roads are clear and accessible so that emergency services can do their jobs. Town hall will remain open in the morning so that services will be available to members of the community."

Due to the anticipated inclement weather, tonight's public information meeting on the Main Street Bridge replacement has been rescheduled for February 2nd. Mayor McCoy is expected to attend.
