

VERNON TRANSFER STATION

Free of Charge - No Permit & Punchcard Required

- 1) Excess Refuse & Recycling throughout the year
- 2) Metal (NEW!)

Items that are at least 75% metal will now be accepted at the Transfer Station free of charge. Does not include freon units (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, and air conditioners). Items such as sleeper sofas or recliners that have only a small amount of metal are now considered bulky items. A permit & punchcard are required to dispose of bulky items.
- 3) Electronic Waste including:

- Desktop computers	- Televisions
- Laptops	- Computer monitors
- Keyboards, power cords, & chargers	- Printers
- Mice or similar pointing devices	- Fax machines & scanners
- PDAs, portable digital music players & other personal e-devices	
- Small electronics including VCRs, DVRs, DVD players, cable receivers, digital converter boxes, or game consoles	
- 4) Yard Waste

Two bundles of brush and one trash bag filled with weeds, tree trimmings, pine cones, pine needles, etc. will be accepted. Large amounts of brush would require a permit & punchcard.
- 5) Single Burnable Item Drop-off Dates (4 times per year)
- 6) Waste Motor Oil & Antifreeze

Put oil and antifreeze into a clean plastic container such as a clean laundry detergent container with a screw-on cap. Label container. Do not mix oil and antifreeze. Leave container at designated area at Transfer Station. (5-gallon max per visit)
- 7) Lead acid batteries
- 8) Mulch (Seasonal)

Free to Vernon residents (proof of residency required). Residents are responsible for loading their own mulch.
- 9) Paper (shredded or unshredded)

Large amounts will be accepted at the Transfer Station. Place SHREDDED paper in a brown paper grocery bag and staple it closed.
- 10) Books/DVDs/VHS tapes & cassettes

"Reading Tree" collection container is available at the Transfer Station. Place books in a cardboard box with lid so that boxes may be stacked within the container.
