VERNON PUBLIC WORKS COMMUNITY DAY

The new date for this event, sponsored by the Vernon Public Works Department, will be held on **SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2018** from 9 AM to Noon at the Public Works Facility at 375 Hartford Turnpike in Vernon. The following activities are scheduled:

- 1) A mobile shredding unit will be available to give Vernon residents the opportunity to have their confidential documents destroyed on site. A maximum of 3 boxes per vehicle will be shred.
- 2) Equipment show and stormwater demonstrations - Check out vehicles of all shapes and sizes including a dump truck, a fire truck, a plow truck, an ambulance, the automated payloader that is used to collect refuse and recycling, and many more. Town and State personnel will be available to answer questions about their jobs and the public will have a chance to explore and climb aboard the big trucks.
- 3) Sign up to receive important information by text, e-mail or voicemail through Vernon's community notification system "Alert Vernon".
- 4) Check out the latest from other Town departments - Fire and Ambulance, Police, Water Pollution Control Authority and the Senior Center.
