CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, CHRISTMAS WRAPPINGS

With the holiday season approaching Vernon residents are urged to recycle as much corrugated cardboard as possible. Cardboard should be cut or folded to fit into recycling carts or bundled and tied into **3 ft x 3 ft stacks 1'** high for those residents with orange recycling bins. It is important to remember untied cardboard placed out for pickup can be difficult to load and can blow around our streets under windy conditions.

Christmas wrappings should be bagged and placed inside refuse carts or bagged and placed next to regular garbage cans. Please do not put wrappings out for pickup in cardboard boxes.
