SNOW GUIDELINES - REMINDER

REMINDER – Vernon Public Works Department is reminding residents that they are **NOT to snow blow, plow, or shovel snow into the street.** This practice creates hazardous conditions for motorists and is an illegal action. If blowing, plowing or shoveling snow into the street creates a hazardous condition and causes an accident the resident will be held responsible.

DPW is also asking residents to keep their children away from the edge of the road during plowing operations. Children playing in tunnels at the side of the road cannot be seen by the plow drivers and can be in danger of being hit by the plow or being buried by the snow if it collapses. It is a very good idea to keep the children away from the snow banks altogether for safety reasons.
