F) PRESENTATIONS BY THE ADMINISTRATION

Mayor George F. Apel to make a presentation to the Town Council on various topics.

- Spoke about the list of liaison appointments and stated there are more to come.
- Created an Ad-Hoc Committee of Council Members Winkler, Motola, Gingras, and Campbell to discuss mayoral compensation. No changes to the mayoral compensation will take place until after 11/2013
- Council Members Campbell, Peterson, and DiDio met to discuss labor agreements set to expire in June
- Council Members Motola, Herbst, and Kopec met to discuss candidates to interview for the Assistant Town Administrator position.
- Mayor Apel did not renew the 2012 lobbyist contract and the Mayor's office no longer has an intern working for them. However, he is in discussion with the University of New Haven for an unpaid internship with a student interested in local government.
- The After Action Report for Storm Alfred is included under informational materials. The Emergency Management Director will meet with the Mayor tomorrow and discuss recommendations, make revisions to the report and bring any policy recommendations to the Town Council.
- The majority of the 2 year plans from Department heads has been received and is under review. Town Council Members are welcome to review them.
- The Finance Department will issue forms to Department Heads for discussions regarding the 2012-2013 budget.
- Mayor Apel will be participating in several different ribbon cutting ceremonies over the next 6-8 weeks.
