Council Member DiDio, seconded by Council Member Winkler made a motion to change Rule 7 as written originally and include a 2/3 vote instead of majority. Motion carried, Council Member Campbell opposed. Rule 7 is amended to read as follows:

7. Any of the rules of the Council may be temporarily suspended by two thirds of the members present and voting in the affirmative, except that in accordance with rule 1, two thirds consent of
