Council Member Weissberger, seconded by Council Member Campbell made the above motion to approve budget amendment #9 for FY 2012-2013. Discussion took place. Motion carried unanimously.

PROPOSED MOTION:

THE TOWN COUNCIL, HEREBY RESOLVES IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER TWELVE (XII) SECTION NINE (9) OF THE TOWN CHARTER, THAT IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE TOWN TO: (1) WAIVE THE TRADITIONAL SEALED BID REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE VDPC, NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) AND NOT TO EXTEND BEYOND JUNE 30, 2013 AND; (2) AUTHORIZE THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR AS THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF VERNON ANY INSTRUMENT(S) TO THAT EFFECT.

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Council Member Winkler, seconded by Council Member DiDio made a motion for an amendment to reduce the amount not to exceed \$9,000.00. Discussion took place. Motion to amend carried, Council Member Sullivan abstained.

Motion as amended carried unanimously.

Council Member Peterson, seconded by Council Member Sullivan made a motion for an amendment for a minimum bid of \$80,000.00 and to assign the property to a realtor which will be selected by Administration. Discussion took place.

Council Member Weissberger, seconded by Council Member Winkler made a motion to amend the amendment with the following motion: The Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Administrator, John D. Ward to sell 13 Morrison Street and assign the listing to a Real Estate Agent. Discussion took place.

Council Member Winkler seconded by Council Member Weissberger called the amendment to the amendment. Motion carried, Council Member Peterson opposed.

Town Council Members voted on the amendment to the amendment, motion carried, Council Member Peterson opposed.

Motion as amended carried unanimously.
