WHEREAS, THE CONNECTICUT REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (CRCOG) HAS SELECTED THIS PROJECT AS A REGIONAL PRIORITY AND HAS AGREED TO UTILIZE FEDERAL FUNDS FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES; AND

WHEREAS, THE TOWN COUNCIL HAS CONSIDERED THE CONCERNS OF THE RESIDENTS FROM THE PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING AND FINDS THAT THE PROPOSED RECONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH STREET PROJECT #146-H024 IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE TOWN OF VERNON AND WILL PROMOTE THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND GENERAL WELFARE OF ITS RESIDENTS AND PROVIDE FOR CONVENIENCE AND SAFETY OF THE MOTORING PUBLIC;
