WHEREAS, the funding source for the sidewalk construction is through the STP-URBAN PROGRAM with a limit of \$1,000,000 per project which includes 80% Federal Participation and 20% Municipal Participations; and

WHEREAS, in response to CRCOG'S RFP the Town has prepared and submitted an application for funding the construction of new sidewalks for various locations throughout the Town; and

WHEREAS, the application was submitted to CRCOG on Wednesday, April 24th, 2013 in the amount of \$907,749 which includes all costs associated with the construction of the sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the design of the sidewalks will be performed by Town Staff; and

WHEREAS, the Vernon Town Council, based on the above information, and by virtue of this resolution, hereby fully supports the proposed project.
