Pledge of allegiance

Mayor Daniel A. Champagne called the public hearing/annual town meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

There were approximately 35 citizens present at the Annual Town Meeting in addition to the Mayor and members of the Town Council.

Town Clerk, Bernice K. Dixon read into the record the legal notice of the Public Hearing/Annual Town Meeting and certified that the notice was posted on the bulletin board in the Town Hall and published in the Journal Inquirer in the April 12, 2014 edition.

Mayor called for nominations for a moderator. Council Member Motola, seconded by Council Member Wakefield made a motion for Finance Officer Jim Luddecke as the moderator. Motion Carried unanimously.

As Moderator Mr. Luddecke explained the requirements necessary to vote at the Referendum as to residence, age and ownership of property.
