Mayor Daniel A. Champagne called the special town meeting to order at 8:00 PM.

Assistant Town Clerk, Karen C. Daigle, read into the record the legal notice of the Special Town Meeting and certified that the notice was posted on the bulletin board in the Town Hall and published in the Journal Inquirer in the September 26, 2015 edition.

Mayor called for nominations for a moderator. Council Member Wakefield, seconded by Council Member Campbell made a motion for Finance Officer Jim Luddecke as the moderator. Motion carried unanimously.

Moderator Mr. Luddecke explained the requirements necessary to vote at the Special Town Meeting as to residence, age and ownership of property.

PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY APPROVES AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION IN AN AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00 TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET, ACCOUNT 10780290.57155, TO FUND THE PURCHASE AND IMPROVEMENTS OF THE PARCEL LOCATED AT 166 UNION STREET, VERNON, CONNECTICUT.

Motion carried by voice vote, with one opposition and one abstention.

Mary Conway, seconded by Bill Dauphin, made a motion to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
