BE IT RESOLVED, THE TOWN COUNCIL AUTHORIZES THE EXPENDITURE OF \$3,761,100.00 IN THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR SCHOOL ROOF REPLACEMENTS AND RENOVATIONS AT THE FOLLOWING SCHOOLS:

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\$872,865.00 FOR THE VERNON CENTER MIDDLE SCHOOL; \$1,231,881.00 FOR NORTHEAST SCHOOL; AND \$1,656,354.00 FOR SKINNER ROAD SCHOOL.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION GRANTS FOR THE ROOF PROJECTS. PROCEEDS OF THE GRANTS ARE TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE TOWN CAPITAL PROJECT FUND TO SUPPORT THE COSTS OF FINANCING THE THREE ROOF PROJECTS.

Council Member Wakefield, seconded by Council Member Appleyard, proposed a resolution to authorize the expenditure of \$3,761,100 in the capital projects fund for school roof replacements and renovations at the following schools: \$872,865 for the Vernon Center Middle School; \$1,231,881 for Northeast School and \$1,656,354 for Skinner Road School; and further authorizes the Board of Education to apply for state department of education grants for the roof projects. Discussion took place. Motion carried unanimously.

5. **Request the Town Council authorize release \$102,088.41 of available funds from projects in the Education Capital and Non-Recurring Expenditure Account.** (See memorandum from James M. Luddecke, Finance Officer and Treasurer to Daniel A. Champagne, Mayor and John D. Ward, Town Administrator dated April 28, 2016 and memorandum from Michael J. Purcaro, Director of Business and Finance dated April 27, 2016 to James M. Luddecke, Finance Officer and Treasurer relative to same.)

THE TOWN COUNCIL APPROVES THE RELEASE FROM COMMITMENT OF UNEXPENDED AMOUNTS FOR COMPLETED PROJECTS IN THE EDUCATION RESERVE FOR CAPITAL AND NON-RECURRING EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$102,088.41. 
