Council Member Motola, seconded by Council Member Peterson made the following motion to go into executive session:

RESOLVED, THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY APPROVES BUDGET AMENDMENT REQUESTS #16, #17, #18, #19, AND #20, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 AS OUTLINED IN THE BUDGET AMENDMENT FORMS PROVIDED BY JAMES M. LUDDECKE, FINANCE OFFICER.

Council Member Motola, seconded by Council Member Appleyard made a motion to open C-3. Motion carried unanimously. Council Member Bush seconded by Council Member Peterson made an amendment to Item #16, snow removal, overtime wages, to reduce said line item from \$48,000 to \$15,000. 1. **Request the Town Council designate \$6800.00 in the Capital Improvement account, to support the purchase of a new vehicle for HVCC.** (See memorandum dated February 25, 2016 from James M. Luddecke, Finance Officer and Treasurer to John D. Ward, Town Administrator relative to same.)

PROPOSED MOTION

THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE DESIGNATION OF \$6800.00 FROM AVAILABLE RESOURCES IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET TO SUPPORT THE ACQUISITION OF A WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE MOTOR VEHICLE BY HOCKANUM VALLEY COMMUNITY COUNCIL FOR SERVICES TO SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES. THE TOTAL COST OF THE VEHICLES IS \$64,420.00, AND THE ALLOCATION TO THE TOWN OF VERNON IS ESTIMATED AT \$6764.80.

Council Member Motola, seconded by Council Member Peterson, made a motion to designate \$6,800.00 from available resources in the capital improvement budget to support the acquisition of a wheelchair accessible motor vehicle by Hockanum Valley Community Council.
