ORDINANCE #2 Water Pollution Control Facility Upgrade

(ACTION – PUBLIC HEARING #2 HELD IN SECTION “E”)

1. Report on the action taken by the Planning and Zoning Commission at its meeting on Thursday, September 6, 2018, relative to 8-24 referrals.
2. Town Council deliberation and decision on adoption of the ordinance.

PROPOSED MOTION #1:

THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY ADOPTS THE PROVISIONS OF BOND ORDINANCE NO. , **“AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$85,972,000 FOR UPGRADES AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN’S WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF BONDS, NOTES AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS TO FINANCE THE PORTION OF THE APPROPRIATION NOT DEFRAID FROM GRANTS.”**

PROPOSED MOTION #2:

THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES THAT A REFERENDUM BE HELD PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER XII, SECTION 12 OF THE TOWN CHARTER, TO BE HELD ON JANUARY 15, 2019, TO APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE FOLLOWING ENTITLED ORDINANCE:

ORDINANCE NO. , “AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$85,972,000 FOR UPGRADES AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN’S WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF BONDS, NOTES AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS TO FINANCE THE PORTION OF THE APPROPRIATION NOT DEFRAID FROM GRANTS.”

THE WORDING OF THE QUESTION SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF VERNON APPROPRIATE \$85,972,000 FOR UPGRADES AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN’S WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS, NOTES AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS TO FINANCE THE PORTION OF THE APPROPRIATION NOT DEFRAID FROM GRANTS?”

VOTERS APPROVING SAID ORDINANCE SHALL VOTE “YES” AND VOTERS OPPOSING SAID ORDINANCE SHALL VOTE “NO”. VOTING SHALL TAKE PLACE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 AM AND 8:00 PM, AT CENTER 375, 375 HARTFORD TURNPIKE (ROUTE 30), VERNON, CONNECTICUT.

PROPERTY OWNERS WHO ARE NOT REGISTERED VOTERS, BUT ARE QUALIFIED TO VOTE AT REFERENDA, SHALL ALSO VOTE AT CENTER 375, 375 HARTFORD TURNPIKE (ROUTE 30), VERNON, CONNECTICUT, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 AM AND 8:00 PM.
