E.) PRESENTATIONS by the administration

1. Presentation to the Town Council by Mayor Jason L. McCoy on a variety of topics.
 - Passed the budget on April 26, Thank you to Town Council Members, Board of Education and Tax Payers
 - Recovered \$253,354 from Travelers Insurance for winter storm costs; due to this insurance pay-out, no lay-offs will be necessary
 - Animal Control crematorium will be in place in July
 - Cemetery purchased and installed a solar light to light the flag at Valley Falls
 - Upgrades to Munis and time matters are complete
 - On May 8, 2011, 300+ people participated in the Mother's Day Dash with proceeds raised to help fund kids to go to camp
 - The 66th annual Easter egg hunt took place
 - Peewee baseball began
 - 40+ adults and children participated in Earth Day activities by fixing up the Platt property and the teen center

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- Due to the passage of the ordinance regarding past due taxes, the Building Department was able to collect \$73,000 in March and \$23,000 in April.
 - The tax collection is on target at 98.4%
 - Prospect Street, phase 3 construction began 5/9/2011
 - Phoenix Street bids opened April 28 and construction is scheduled to begin on June 1, 2011 – Lag Warner Construction won the bid
 - Roosevelt Mills is currently in the process of contracting for fencing and protections in certain areas
 - Ellington Avenue applications are due on June 1
 - Parks and Recreation Department's Community Garden is ready for use
 - \$6,000 in repairs is needed for the pool and in addition to the heading source for the showers
 - Damage to Legion Field roads need fixing approximately \$11,000 to fix
 - Trail Days will take place on June 4, 2011
 - The Fire Marshall is scheduling a presentation for Town Council members to speak about his 3 new projects.
 - Planning and Zoning received, reviewed and signed off on the Planning Conservation Development Plan, draft presented at public hearing on June 9
 - The Rockville Fish and Game Club approved construction of the police shooting range
 - Police Department website has been upgraded
 - Public Works Dept is working on stormwater permit renewals for transfer station and garage.
 - Awarded Grant for emergency generator at VCMS, generator on order
 - DPW ordered fuel cell system for Captain Clark's car.
 - DPW will start grinding/paving sequence on May 23rd for Wilshire Rd, Seneca Dr., Barbara Dr. Neil, and Neil Dr., Gerald Dr., John Dr.
 - Social Services helped 100 people with their tax returns; their renter rebate and summer campership program will continue through the summer
 - Senior Center stage is being carpeted and has several activities planned
 - WPCA began Chemical treatment pilot program for Rte 30 and Center Rd. off the rails to trails area. They are also testing a microturbine to generate power
 - Freedom of Information requests were distributed.
