E) PRESENTATIONS by the administration

C 1 **Request for Tax Refunds for the Current Year.** (A copy of a memorandum from Terry Hjarne, Collector of Revenue, to John D. Ward, Town Administrator dated September 26, 2011 is included in the Council packet.)

MOTION:

THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY APPROVES TWENTY-FOUR (24) REFUNDS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR TOTALLING \$3,165.84 OUTLINED IN THE MEMORANDUM FROM TERRY HJARNE, COLLECTOR OF REVENUE TO JOHN D. WARD, TOWN ADMINISTRATOR DATED SEPTEMBER 26, 2011.

Council Member Krupienski, seconded by Council Member Campbell made the above motion to approve the request for tax refunds for the current year. Motion carried unanimously.

C 3. **Request the Town Council authorize Mayor Jason L. McCoy to sign the Memorandum of Agreement regarding the use of Federal Grant Funding and Custodial Ownership of Regional Assets from the State of Connecticut Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security.** (A copy of a memorandum dated September 29, 2011 from John D. Ward, Town Administrator to Mayor Jason L. McCoy and the Vernon Town Council is included for Council review.)

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PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN OF VERNON MAY ENTER INTO WITH AND DELIVER TO THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS WHICH IT DEEMS TO BE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT JASON L. MCCOY AS THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF VERNON IS AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF VERNON AND TO DO AND PERFORM ALL ACTS AND THINGS WHICH HE DEEMS TO BE NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE TO CARRY OUT.

Council Member Krupienski , seconded by Council Member Champagne made the above resolution to authorize the Mayor to sign the memorandum of agreement regarding the use of federal grant funding and custodial ownership of regional assets from the State of Connecticut Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security. Discussion took place. Motion carried unanimously.

- C 5.** **Request the Town Council approve the submission and funding of the 2011 AFG FEMA grant applications by the Vernon Fire Department for Apparatus/Equipment, and authorizes Mayor Jason L. McCoy or his designee to execute any and all documents necessary for the same.** (A copy of a memorandum from John D. Ward, Town Administrator to Vernon Town Council dated September 29, 2011, and a copy of the narrative submitted by the Fire Department, is included for Council review.)

PROPOSED MOTION:

THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE APPLICATION FOR THE 2011 AFG FEMA FIRE GRANT FOR APPARATUS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$471,675.00 AND UPON ACCEPTANCE, THE TOWN COUNCIL WILL APPROPRIATE UP TO \$47,167.50 TO FUND THE TOWN'S SHARE. THE TOWN COUNCIL FURTHER AUTHORIZES MAYOR JASON L. MCCOY OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE SAME.

Council Member Krupienski, seconded by Council Member Champagne made the above motion to approve the submission and funding of the 2011 AFG FEMA grant applications by the Vernon Fire Department for Apparatus/Equipment, and authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute any and all documents necessary for the same. Discussion took place. Motion carried unanimously.

- C 6.** **Request the Town Council approve a bid waiver for the repair/rebuild of the chimney at the Vernon Center Middle School to be paid for from the Board of Education's Capital and Non-recurring Fund.** (A copy of a memorandum dated September 30, 2011 from John D. Ward, Town Administrator to Mayor Jason L. McCoy and the Town Council is included for Council review.)

PROPOSED MOTION:

RESOLVED, THE TOWN COUNCIL CONSISTENT WITH THE TOWN CHARTER, CHAPTER 12, SECTION 9, HEREBY WAIVES THE BID PROCEDURE FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF THE CHIMNEY AT VERNON CENTER MIDDLE SCHOOL. AS PART OF SAID WAIVER, THREE QUOTES WILL BE OBTAINED AND THE WORK WILL BE AWARDED TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE SERVICE PROVIDER.

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Council Member Krupienski, seconded by Council Member Champagne made the above motion to approve a bid waiver for the repair/rebuild of the chimney at VCMS to be paid for from the Board of Education's capital and non-recurring fund. Discussion took place. Council Member Herbst recommends postpone this motion until the Board of Education brings the item before the Town Council.

Council Member Krupienski, seconded by Council Member Herbst made a motion to table the item until October 18 meeting. Council Member Herbst requested a friendly amendment to postpone the item instead of table it, Council Member Krupienski accepted friendly amendment. Motion carried, Council Member Campbell opposed.

Discussion took place in reference to Planning and Conservation Development Plan and upcoming hearing on October 13. The Planning and Conservation Development is looking for comments from the Council Members. Council Member Krupienski urged council members to review the plan that was provided to them at a past meeting and provide comments to staff. Council Member Schaefer made a suggestion that the public hearing on the Planning and Conservation Development Plan covered on the public access channel.
