Council Member Winkler, seconded by Council Member Herbst made a motion to move the question and vote on the amendment to allow hunting on property as authorized by the Department of Environmental Protection, motion carried, Council Members Campbell and Anderson opposed.

The amendment regarding allowing hunting on the property failed, Council Members Herbst, Schaefer, Motola, Winkler, Champagne, and Krupienski opposed.
