Important Storm Information

Vernon Mayor George Apel has declared a Civil Preparedness State of Emergency for the Town of Vernon in anticipation of Hurricane Sandy.

An emergency shelter will be located at the Vernon Center Middle School, 777 Hartford Turnpike, Vernon, CT. The shelter will open at 5:00pm on Sunday, October 28, 2012. Bring medications, bedding, towels and personal hygiene items with you to the shelter. No meal will be served until Monday morning. Pets are permitted but must be caged.

A town-wide parking ban will be in effect from 0700 am on Monday, October 29 until 0700 am Wednesday, October 31.

Vernon Public Schools will be cancelled for Monday and Tuesday. Stay tuned to local media for further updates on school closings.

There will be no trash collection on Monday or Tuesday.

Stay away from downed power lines. Report emergencies and downed lines to 911. The Town of Vernon Emergency Operations call center can be reached at 860-872-9126. This call center will open at midnight Sunday evening. For additional information and updates go to www.vernon-ct.gov
