1. Welcome

2. Review of 4/22/20 minutes:

A motion to accept the 4/22/20 draft minutes as presented was made, seconded, and passed unanimously.

1. Real Talk Vernon updates

- a. Vaping PSA progress: The Real Talk vaping PSA is temporarily on hold due to the school closure. Planning and filming of the PSA will resume when students are able to go back to school.
- b. Netflix Parties with Manchester: To keep Manchester and Vernon youth connected, there have been several Netflix Parties and discussions over the past month. The group has watched movies that are motivational with strong messages, and in the future plans are to watch more educational movies/shows that focus on different substances.
- c. Instagram posts & challenges: On Instagram and Facebook, the coalition has had several different "challenges" to keep followers engaged. There has been a "Pet Positivity" challenge, an Instagram story "Quarantine Challenge," and an art contest.
- d. Real Talk campaign new designs coming soon: Coalition members and Real Talk members have been in touch with a new marketing agency that's working on designing a new version of the Real Talk campaign. The messaging is similar to the last version of the campaign, but it focused on students making the right choice.
- e. Real Talk CADCA Vlog: The CADCA vlog has been completed and is available for viewing on YouTube and the coalition website. The vlog is focused around Real Talk members' experiences at CADCA and what they learned while attending the conference.

2. MVPP updates

- a. MVPP Youth Advisory Board: MVPP Youth Advisory board members had a virtual meeting on 4/7/20. The focus of the meeting was to discuss the designs and messaging for the digital billboards which will be on I-84 for several weeks in May, including National Prevention Week. The billboard will incorporate both the Real Talk and FACTS logos.
