NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BOLTON LAKES REGIONAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY

The Bolton Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority will hold a public hearing in the Bolton Town Hall, 222 Bolton Center Road, in Bolton, Connecticut, on March 30, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. to consider the advisability of construction of the Phase III Construction Project portion of a regional sewerage system to serve the portions of the Bolton Lakes defined as the "Lakes District" and the "Southwestern District" in the concurrent ordinances entitled "An Ordinance Creating The Bolton Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority" approved by the Town of Bolton and the Town of Vernon on April 1, 2003 and April 5, 2003, respectively. The Phase III Construction Project generally consists of the portion of the regional sewerage system commencing at the end of Phase II in the vicinity of the boat ramp to Bolton Lake in Bolton, extending easterly along Boston Turnpike to the Coventry town line; continuing north along Tolland Road to Bolton Branch Road and ending at the Vernon Town line; also branching off Tolland Road to Cubles Drive and ending at the Vernon Town line; with an segment of Colonial Road that begins in the vicinity of the intersection of Cubles Drive with Colonial Road. The project also encompasses High Meadow Road, Sunset Lane as well as the easternmost segment of Plymouth Lane, and the related spur lines and appurtenances, as more fully described in the report entitled "Preliminary Design Report for Bolton Lakes Sewer Project, Prepared for the Towns of Vernon and Bolton, Connecticut" dated January, 2008 and prepared by Fuss and O'Neill, Inc. A copy of said report is on file in the offices of the Authority and in the offices of the Town Clerks of the Towns of Bolton and Vernon, and available for inspection during normal business hours.

Electors and citizens qualified to vote in the Towns of Bolton and Vernon, Connecticut and affected property owners will be heard at the public hearing concerning the proposed sewer project.
