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Minutes for LPC and YSBAB  
September 16, 2014

Attending: Paula Plante, Kim McTighe, Steve Langlais and Alan Slobodien

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1. There was no SSNAP report. First meeting of the group is next week.
2. Discussion focused on use of current Drug Free Communities grant funds. Those present decided the following:
  - a. Purchase up-to-date breathalyzers for use at school functions - \$3,258.29
  - b. Support speakers at KIDSAFE CT drop-in center - \$1,000
3. Discussion moved to the 2014-15 LPC (Local Prevention Council) grant from ERASE. It was decided to distribute the \$4,245 grant as follows:
  - a. \$2,000 in support of police compliance checks of alcohol sellers; 1 compliance check in December 2014 and 1 check in April 2015
  - b. \$800 for the purchase of educational materials for distribution as community events such as National Night Out
  - c. \$1,245 to support staff at the KIDSAFE CT drop-in center
4. Alan reported that the YSB summer lunch program increased lunches served by 5.5% from last summer. In 2013, 6,229 lunches were served and in 2014 6,576 lunches were served. Henry Park and Park West Apartments locations realized increases in lunches served while Maple Street School saw a significant decrease (450 lunches). Talcott Park remained level.
5. Those present agreed to invite Jim Harrison, VCMS Principal to the November 18<sup>th</sup> meeting to discuss how the Council can support prevention activities at the middle school.

The meeting adjourned at 3:30pm following item #5 discussion.
