1. Page 1-1 of 2 Item #8 Would the Town approve refurbished equipment to be used at the Transfer Station?
 - a. Yes, as long as the containers operate properly do not have holes or other hazards, and are freshly painted
2. Page 1-2 of 2 Item #12 states bids must be accompanied by bid security in the sum of not less than 5%. On page S1-1 of 2 Item #3 it states a bid bond in the amount of 10% shall be provided with the Proposal. Please advise if a 5% or 10% bid bond is required for this Proposal.
 - a. 5% of the total value of the contract
3. Page S1-1 of 2 states the Contractor shall provide a performance and labor and material bonds. Will a labor and material bond be required as part of the contract?
 - a. No
4. Page S-3 of 4 Please advise what permits and licenses are required for this contract.
 - a. Applicable state and local permits for hauling and/or disposal
5. Page S-3 of 4 Item f In the past two (2) years how often have additional dumpsters been ordered?
 - a. 5-10 times
6. Page S-3 of 4 Item c Are there any current plans to add additional acceptable materials at the Transfer Station?
 - a. No
7. Does the Town pay the tip fee for bulky waste and recyclables?
 - a. Yes
8. Page S-4 of 4 Item e States recyclables are delivered to Mid-Connecticut Regional Recycling Center. On the bid proposal page P-2 of 5 it asks for pricing for hauling to Willimantic Waste. Please advise which is correct.
 - a. The Town currently has a contract for MSW and recyclables that includes an option for bulky to be accepted at Willimantic Waste so a bidder can provide pricing for hauling only to Willimantic or hauling and disposal to another facility.
9. Page S-4 of 4 States bulky is delivered to Shoham Road or Willimantic Waste. Bid proposal sheet asks for pricing only to Willimantic Waste. Please advise which location bulky waste is delivered to.
 - a. Same as 8
