Final Design Services – Main Street Bridge over the Tankerhoosen River

The Town of Vernon is accepting Statements of Qualifications from civil engineering firms experienced in bridge design with familiarity in the Federal/Local Bridge Program and/ or LOTCIP requirements for the provision of a design services for bridge projects. Respondents must be licensed in the State of Connecticut, be in good standing and have demonstrated experience in adhering to the standards and requirements of performing such services.

This project is funded through the Federal/Local Bridge program. Preliminary design services were completed by Dewberry Engineering, and the town is looking for a qualified design firm to complete the final design phase with the option to provide construction administration/inspection services, should the town elect to extend the initial scope of services. The preliminary design and supporting information is available for review on the town's website www.vernon-ct.gov/legal-notices referencing #2018.

Statements of qualifications should include, at minimum, the resumes of key personnel assigned to the project, a list of subcontractors to be used and a detailed work experience related to similar projects over the last 5 years. All responses will be reviewed and 5 firms will be selected to interview. Respondents should provide three (3) hard copies and one digital copy of their Statement of Qualifications. All submissions shall be provided in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on the outside of the envelope as follows: ***“RFQ #2018 – Main Street Bridge over the Tankerhoosen River to Town of Vernon, Mr. Michael Purcaro, Town Administrator, 14 Park Place, 3rd Floor, Vernon CT 06066 by 11:00 am on 5/24/2018. Minority Owned Business Enterprise/ Women's Business Enterprise / Small Business Enterprise are encouraged to apply. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all applications in whole or in part, to award any one service or group of services or all services, to negotiate with any or all companies submitting qualifications, and to enter into an agreement with any company for any services mentioned in this RFQ if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.
