- Starting Point for Annual Manchester Hockanum River Canoe Race
- Add Signage for HRLP Trail Access
- Connect to Tinkenhosen River Trail
- Connect to Vernon Falls-to-Trails

Trail Segment Five
Manchester Line to Dart Hill Road
- Start at Theocrite Congregational Church or New Parking Area at Union Street
- Use Abandoned Train Lanes for Connecting Trail Loop and Dart Hill Road
- Connect to Valley Falls Park and Valley Falls Park
- The new Tinkenhosen Historical Walking Tour

Trail Segment Two
Dart Hill Road to Hydebrook Road
- Dart Hill Road to Hydebrook Road
- Parking at Hydebrook
- Connection to Rockville-Tinkenhosen River Trail and Valley Falls Park
- Abandoned Rail Lines over Dart Hill Road Region
- Road/Center Road

Trail Segment Three
Ellington Marsh
- Start at Ellington Marsh
- Loop Trail from Ellington Marsh
- Connect to Ellington Park
- Park at Sewage Treatment Plant and Senior Housing
- Connect to Rockville/Segment Four Along Road on Route 83

Trail Segment Four
Rockville
- Connect from Ellington Marsh Segment Three along Road
- Start at West Side Veterans Memorial Park
- The new Historical Walking Tour
- Terminates at Shempan Lake the Sources of the Hockanum River
