Notice is given to Town of Vernon taxpayers that I have received a rate bill and warrant to collect a town tax of 39.63 mills on real estate, personal property and motor vehicles, on the Grand List of October 1, 2019 with a due date of July 1, 2020.

MOTOR VEHICLE TAXES

Motor Vehicle Taxes must be paid in full on or before August 3, 2020 after which the tax becomes delinquent, subject to interest and will be reported to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles as provided by Law.

REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

Each Real Estate and Personal Property bill totaling \$100.00 must be paid in full on or before August 3, 2020. Taxpayers whose tax bills are over \$100.00 have the option of paying the full amount due or the First Installment by August 3, 2020. Failure to pay by August 3, 2020 renders the installment delinquent and subject to interest. Taxpayers must pay the second installment due January 1, 2021 on or before February 1, 2021 to avoid penalties.

Failure to pay on or before August 3, 2020, will render bills delinquent and subject to interest at the rate of 1 ½% per month from the due date of July 1, 2020. Minimum interest charge is \$2.00. Exceptions may apply to those who applied for deferment under Executive Order 7S & 7W.
