MATTRESS AND BOX SPRING DISPOSAL

The Town of Vernon announced that effective Wednesday, January 13, 2010 mattresses **and** box springs would require an additional punch each on punch card for disposal at the Transfer Station. All mattresses and box springs **regardless of size** would require the additional punch.

Disposal regulations do not allow mattresses and/or boxsprings to be collected with weekly curbside service. Residents have the option of either bringing mattresses and/or boxsprings to the Vernon Transfer Station or calling the Public Works Department at 860-870-3500 to schedule a **PAID** bulk pickup.

The Transfer Station hours of operation are Wednesdays and Saturdays 8 AM-4 PM and Sundays 12:00 Noon-4 PM. A permit and punchcard are required.

When purchasing a new mattress and/or boxspring residents should consider arranging with the store where new item (s) were purchased the disposal of old mattress and/or boxspring.
