1. CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 7:09 p.m. by Scott Wieting.

2. ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS

A. Acceptance of Minutes of February 23, 2009

C. Application related Correspondences: IWC and PZC applications

IWC-2009-01 – Town of Vernon, drainage improvements for Ironwood Drive and #259 Phoenix Street – approved by the IWC

IWC-2009-02 – Ticket Network, 60 S. Frontage Road – received on April 15, 2009, redesignation.

IWC-2009-03 – Town of Vernon & Recreation Dept to rebuild 170 ft of Braille trail at Valley Falls Park with a concrete surface 4 ft wide x 5 ft deep.

Motion was made by Lawrence Geissler, Jr. to write a letter to the IWC to voice the concerns of the Commission regarding if enough is being done to prevent future erosion. The correction process is not clear and the Commission would like the Town Engineer look closer at the plans. Motion was seconded by Scott Sierakowski. Motion carried unanimously.

PZC-2009-04– Rockville Public Library addition – there are no wetlands surrounding the area.

PZC-2009-05 - 75 Talcottville Road (Sonoco near Tri-City Plaza) – reconfiguring to a Convenience Store.

There are no wetlands however the property abuts a property in the wetlands.

PZC- 2009-07 – Vernon Historical Society – the addition in rear to make it handicap accessible
No wetlands.

PZC-2009-08 – 560 Talcottville Road, applicant Sovereign Bank, vacant Car Dealership - modification to approved plans for bank use.

The rear part of the existing structure will be demolished which will result in the proposed development being further away from the wetlands than originally approved.

Elaine A. Sych, ERT Coordinator of the Ct. ERT Program also attended the meeting.

A walking tour of the Bolton Lakes is planned for April 29th.

Lawrence Geissler, Jr. will contact Len Tundermann to discuss this again.

Marina Rodriquez will review the original language changes that were proposed and revise accordingly for discussion with Len and Lawrence. This will be emailed to Lawrence Geissler, Jr. Signs are now posted on Reservoir Road and Bolton Road.
