The Capitol Region East Operation Committee (CREOC) serves the residents of Vernon, Glastonbury, Hebron, Manchester, Marlborough, Somers and Stafford for the collection of household hazardous waste. **All collections are on Saturdays from 8 AM to 1 PM.**

COLLECTION SITE

Olcott Street, Manchester (Exit 1 from 384, left onto Spencer Street for 0.9 miles, left onto Olcott Street, follow signs to Facility.) Please bring a drivers license, tax bill or car registration to prove residency.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

From the House - drain cleaners, arts & crafts supplies, metal polish, aerosol cans, dry cleaning fluids, rechargeable batteries, oven cleaners, photo chemicals, floor cleaners, fluorescent light bulbs



From the Garage - fire starters, chemistry kits, engine & radiator flushes, waxes & polishes



From the Workbench - rust preventative, wood preservative, oil-based paints, paint thinners, solvents, wood strippers, degreasers



From the Yard - pesticides/herbicides, rodent killers, muriatic acid, cesspool cleaners, fertilizers, insect sprays, pool chemicals



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Asbestos (call the Public Works Office at 870-3500 for disposal options), Smoke Detectors, Compressed Gas Cylinders, Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives, Prescription Medicines/Syringes, Commercial or Industrial Waste, Infectious and Biological Waste, Radioactive Waste, Fire Extinguishers and Water-Based (Latex) Paints.



ACCEPTED WITH WEEKLY CURBSIDE PICKUP

LATEX PAINT - Place lids with weekly refuse. Empty cans or cans with hardened paint will be accepted. Kitty litter, saw dust, sand or "Speedy Dry" may be added to paint to help solidify. Max 4 cans weekly.

NEEDLE/SYRINGE DISPOSAL - Place sharps in opaque plastic container. Seal container with original lid and wrap with duct tape. Label the container "**Do Not Recycle**" and place with refuse.



ACCEPTED AT TRANSFER STATION

WASTE MOTOR OIL/ANTIFREEZE - May be dropped off at our Transfer Station. A permit and punchcard is not required. Max 5 gallons per visit.
