2.2 Acceptance of Minutes

3. DISCUSSION/ACTIONS/ADDITIONAL BUSINESS

- 3.1 Application (**IWC-2009-03**) of Town of Vernon, Parks and Recreation, to rebuild approximately 170 linear feet of the Braille trail at Valley Falls Park with a concrete surface 4 ft. wide x 5 in. deep (Assessor's ID: Map #34, Block #0135, Lot/Parcel #0010C)

George Arthur attended the meeting in place of Bruce Dinnie. He explained that this was originally an Eagle Scout project. He commented that Bruce Dinnie and Ann Letnedre received a grant to solve the erosion problem in the wetlands only. He pointed out that a concrete contractor had been hired.

The Commission felt that the people dealing with the issue have a lot of experience and as long as the concrete followed the contour of the land all agreed this was the best option for preserving the trail and no public hearing would be necessary.

Motion was made by John Kopec to approve the application **IWC-2009-03**. Motion was seconded by Jeffrey Pescosolido. Motion carried unanimously.

3.2 Receipt of Applications & Determination of Significance/Scheduling of Public Hearing

Application (**IWC-2009-02**) of Ticket Network Forest, LLC for redesignation of wetlands on property at #60 Frontage Road (Assessor's ID: Map #29., Block #0134, Lot/Parcel #0001)

This redesignation requires a public hearing.

Motion was made by Mark Kalina to accept the application and schedule a public hearing for the May 26, 2009 meeting providing a soil scientist's report is received.

Motion was seconded by Jeffrey Pescosolido. Motion carried unanimously.


3. ADJOURNMENT
