The Vernon Planning and Zoning Commission (PZC) has scheduled a Public Scoping Meeting for November 12, 2009. The meeting will be held at the Vernon Senior Center, second floor meeting room, 26 Park Place at 7:00 PM. The meeting, which is open to the public, will feature interactive exercises and open forum discussions regarding planning, conservation and development issues. The purpose of the meeting is to gain citizen input on land issues affecting the Town of Vernon as it develops an updated State mandated Plan of Conservation and Development. It is being held during the initial phase of the Plan that will serve the needs of the residents of Vernon during the decade of 2010-2019.

To assist in developing the Plan, Vernon PZC has employed Planimetrics of Avon as a consultant. Planimetrics is a multidisciplinary consulting firm with demonstrated expertise in planning and zoning, public participation and development consulting services for public agencies and private clients. The Plan is scheduled to be completed in late 2010.
