

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 242
CREATING THE BOLTON LAKES REGIONAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL
AUTHORITY**

ORDINANCE NO. _____

Be it Ordained by the Town of Vernon that:

Paragraph IV. JURISDICTION of Ordinance # 242, An Ordinance Creating the Bolton Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority, adopted by the Town of Vernon on April 5, 2003, is hereby amended as follows:

IV. JURISDICTION

The last sentence of Paragraph IV "**Properties may be added to the District only if both Towns adopt an amendment to this Ordinance providing for such addition**" will be deleted.

The sentence "**Properties may be added to the Jurisdictional Area in either District by the adoption, by a two-thirds vote of the entire Board of Directors of the BLRWPCA, of a resolution to add such properties to the Jurisdictional Area in either District**" will be added.

If this amendment is adopted, the paragraph will read as follows:

The jurisdiction of the BLRWPCA shall be limited to those areas shown and designated as the "Lakes District Sewer Service Area" and the "Southwestern District Sewer Service Area" on a map entitled, "Bolton Lakes Area Designations November 1, 2002 Bolton/Vernon Connecticut Proj. No.: 94117.A10 Date: November 2002 Fig. 2," prepared by Fuss & O'Neill, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 146 Hartford Road, Manchester, Connecticut 06040, which map is or will be filed in the offices of the Town Clerks of the Towns of Bolton and Vernon. Properties may be added to the Jurisdictional Area in either District by the adoption, by a two-thirds vote of the entire Board of Directors of the BLRWPCA, of a resolution to add such properties to the Jurisdictional Area in either District.
