The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

1. A motion was made by Morgan, seconded by Fetko, for acceptance of the minutes from the July 12 meeting. Bettinger noted three corrections in that Chief Kenny was incorrectly identified as Captain Kenny. Changes made. Motion to accept as amended made by Morgan. Passed unanimously.
2. Request for "Not a Through Street" sign on Lily Lane

Letter to Traffic Authority from Mr. James Millen 38 Lily Lane read to panel requesting "Not a through Street" sign be erected to help remove traffic on street mistakenly believing Lily Lane a through street. Ms. Loretta Donovan, 11 Lily Lane appeared in support of sign application.

A discussion was held. Fetko indicated the sign should be "No Outlet" instead of sign requested.

A motion to approve "No Outlet Sign" be erected as allowed by time constraints and budget of the Public Works Department, by Morgan, second by Bettinger. Passed Unanimously.

3. Application review of site plan for 117 Reservoir Road, applicant Richard Hayes Jr.

A brief discussion was held. Kenny indicated application had been rejected by P/Z. The developer has entered into a lawsuit against the town.

A motion made by Morgan to postpone the review without prejudice until the lawsuit is settled. seconded by Bettinger and unanimously approved.

4. Application review for 695 Talcottville Road, applicant Vernon Associates.

Discussion held regarding application as it is a zoning change and had no effect on traffic.

A motion for no action to be taken was made by Morgan, seconded by Bettinger and unanimously approved.

5. Application review special permit, 45 Sunset Terrance, applicant David Charette.

Application to install new driveway at proposed single family residence, 45 Sunset Terrance. Motion to accept application as detailed in plot plan by Fetko, Second by Morgan. Passed Unanimously.

Discussion was held regarding the status of Town ordinance #238, Nighttime parking. Information appears that ordinance was passed as part of consent agenda at October 7, 2003 Town Council Meeting. Kenny to check status with Town Clerk.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m. Motion by White, second by Bettenger, passed unanimously.
