


TRANSFER STATION



LOCATION: Hockanum Boulevard (off Rt. 83 across from Vernon "Spare Time" bowling lanes).


HOURS OF OPERATION: Wednesday & Saturday 8 AM - 4 PM / Sunday 12 Noon - 4 PM.

HOW TO OBTAIN PERMITS / PUNCHCARDS: Permits and punchcards may be obtained at the Tax Office at the Town Hall Annex. Permits must be purchased annually and are good for the fiscal year July 1-June 30. **Punchcards do not expire.** Vehicle registration and a driver's license must be shown.

Friday	8:30 AM - 1:00 PM


PUNCHCARDS: Entry into the Transfer Station will require the purchase of a punchcard as well as a permit. Punchcards may be purchased at the same time permit is issued or at any other time throughout the year. Note: Loss of punchcard will require the purchase of a new punchcard.



FEE SCHEDULE (effective 7/1/08)

Annual Permit (per vehicle)	\$ 5.00
Ten-Entry Punchcard	\$60.00

FREON UNITS: (Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers) Disposal costs dictate an additional fee be charged. To avoid handling cash at the Transfer Station, cards will receive 4 punches per freon unit (effective 7/1/08, 3 punches per freon unit).



Plan ahead! Do you have enough punches available on your punchcard to dispose of a freon unit?

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR DISPOSAL

Brush - Up to 3" in diameter and less than 6' in length.

Oversized Bulky Items - Sleep sofas, recliners, building materials (asphalt shingles in small quantities only)

Metals - Grills, bikes, swing sets, lawn mowers, propane tanks (empty-30 lb. max), miscellaneous scrap



Appliances - Freon units, stoves, washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, fans, etc.

Waste Motor Oil & Antifreeze - Put oil and antifreeze into clean plastic container such as clean laundry detergent container with a screw-on cap. Label container. Do not mix oil and antifreeze. Leave container at designated area at Transfer Station. 5 gallon max per visit.



Tires - 2 per visit - unmounted or mounted



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

No household garbage, cardboard or recyclables

No car or truck parts

No hazardous waste (**NOTE:** Furnaces/boilers will no longer be accepted at the Transfer Station or with Weekly Scheduled Bulk/Metal Pickup. These items are considered hazardous waste.)

No grass, leaves, large limbs, logs or stumps

No commercial vehicles, contractors or businesses allowed

No vehicles with dump bodies allowed
