7. **AQUATIC INVASIVES**

The Commission received a report from George Knoecklin, PhD., from Northeast Aquatic Research explaining his recommendations for treatment to Valley Falls and Walker Reservoir. This information will be presented at a Public Meeting on Wednesday.

The Commission had several questions and concerns such as:

- Acute Toxicity
- What would the impact be on insect larvae?
- What can be done to retain nutrients from highway runoff? (biofilter)
- Potential oxygen depletion
- Can the recommended treatments be done in segments so vegetation does not die all at once?
- What happens to the dead plants? Will there be new growth?

The Commission will communicate comments after George Knoecklin's presentation at the Public meeting and the comments will be sent to the Town Council to get on the agenda for the March 16, 2010 meeting.

Thomas Ouellette made a motion to write a letter to be presented to the Town Council for the meeting March 16th.

Motion was seconded by Ryan Goad. Motion carried unanimously.

Ryan Goad briefed the Commission on the presentation for Planimetrics, November 12, 2009. Heidi requested that the commission streamline their specific goals.


The Commission listed the following goals:
