FREE ELECTRONICS DROP-OFF

January 25, 2010

The Town of Vernon Public Works Department is pleased to announce that the Transfer Station will accept electronics free of charge from Vernon residents on the following dates: Wednesday, February 3 (8 AM to 4 PM); and Saturday, February 6 (8 AM to 4 PM).

To obtain free entry into the facility, residents must have **electronics only** and proof of Vernon residency. Electronics mixed with bulky waste or metal will require a permit and a punchcard. **No commercial electronics will be accepted.**

All incoming electronics will be recycled. Acceptable items include all computer equipment including hard drives, printers, fax machines, modems, answering machines, televisions, VCRs, CD players, cell phones, stereo and radio equipment, toners and cartridges, and televisions.

A permit and punchcard will **not** be required for this disposal.
