VSRC Mission: To ensure that every child in Vernon will start school ready to learn

I. Welcome and Introductions

II. Review and Approval of draft minutes for 2/2/2022

Motion to accept minutes as presented was made by Kimberly, seconded by Betsy. All were in favor and motion passed.

III. Purpose of VSRC- School Readiness Chair Michelle Hill reviewed the following:

OEC PPT was shared a few months ago. Purposes listed below. The SR Grant is a great deal of work but the Council is broader with a focus of improving Vernon's birth to 8 system.

- 1 Empower parents to move the public will in the interest of Vernon's children.
- 2. Partner with businesses, families, community and other stakeholders to develop a network that will strengthen the early childhood experience for Vernon children and their families.
- 3. Ensure compliance with Public Act 97-259, an Act concerning School Readiness and Child Day Care.
- 4. Seek financial and other resources to sustain children's initiatives in Vernon.

Of note: Our SRC could use more business members (they possibly could help with getting information out and collecting data)

IV. Strengthening Local Early Childhood Collaboration- Vernon's Better Together Initiative -

A. Status update

VBT applied for continuation funding to uplift and engage families. Additional funding has provided us an opportunity to do that.

Question: How do our meetings become more parent friendly? What can we do to make the meetings welcoming and inviting? Engaging parent as a way to improve our system?

- -Allison suggested giving them something to do...not just attend meetings. Bring back baby fair. Ready, Set, School Fair- specific ways for parents to contribute.
- -Families can be "hard to find" Sherry added starting with babies as an initial connection and collaborating with families.
